Instructions for filling out the Scholarship Application

Bethesda Soccer Club is pleased to offer a Scholarship program to help families offset club fees. The club has a limited number of scholarships available and the number of players receiving aid and the amount of the scholarship will vary depending on the funds available. Scholarships are funded by contributions, camp and tournament proceeds.

In order to be considered for a scholarship for the Spring season, applicants must complete all the information on the following pages and submit this application to the club by February 12, 2010. If any information is incorrect or missing, the application will NOT be considered. Late applications will NOT be considered.

Applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee . All information will be kept confidential.

The Scholarship committee will send out notification to all applicants, regardless of outcome, by March 1, 2010.

Scholarships are awarded based upon demonstrated need. Financial need will be the only determinant in receiving a scholarship. Families will be responsible for paying any uniform, club, coaching or team expenses not covered by the scholarship. Scholarship figures will be assigned as follows:

- 75%: This assessment means that a family is responsible for 25% of the program fee. Families are asked to perform 8 hours of volunteer work in the awarded season.
- 50%: This assessment means that a family is responsible for 50% of the program fee. Families are asked to perform 6 hours of volunteer work in the awarded season.
- 25%: This assessment means that a family is responsible for 75% of the program fee. Families are asked to perform 4 hours of volunteer work in the awarded season.

This application will be good for the Spring 2010 soccer season.
