## COSTS INCLUDED IN U13 – U18 PLAYER FEES

- BSC Club Fees
- MSYSA Registration and/or US Club Registration
- Fall and Spring Practice Sessions: Two sessions per week (locations may include the MD Soccerplex, Bretton Woods, Georgetown Prep, Walter Johnson HS, Norwood, Blair HS or Holy Cross)  
For HS teams sitting out fall seasons, we will be providing weekend sessions for training for the fall season.
- Winter Practice Sessions: Two practice sessions per week on high-quality outdoor fields or indoor space
- Goalkeeper Training: Weekly specialized training for Team Goalies
- Speed & Agility, Fitness and Strength Training
- Team Coaching Fees & Director of Coaching Support
- 2011/2012 League Fees (WAGS, NCSL, OBSL, Region I, Elite Clubs National League)
- Game Fields -MD Soccerplex
- Five(5) non-BSC tournaments – 2 fall and 3 spring/summer
- BSC Thanksgiving tournament
- State Cup fees and fields
- Coaches travel, hotel, and per diem expenses for tournament travel

The fee **does not** include player uniforms, warm-ups, practice jerseys, or player travel-related costs.

### **Fees:**

Fees are determined annually on a per player basis. You will be notified by your manager or coach each July of the fees for the new season.

### **Mid Season roster additions/transfers:**

Fees for Players added/transferred during a season will be assessed as follows:

Nov/Dec addition	60%	of annual per player fee
Jan/Feb	50%	of annual per player fee
Mar and beyond	40%	of annual per player fee

## **For Teams Sitting out HS Season:**

Fees for Players on High School Age teams that sit out during the HS season:

Jan/Feb addition	80%	of annual per player fee
March addition	70%	of annual per player fee
April addition	50%	of annual per player fee

## **Injured Players:**

A Player injured for three (3) months or more may receive a reduction in the player fee provided he or she applies to the club for a reduction and provides a doctor's report on the condition of the player, the probable duration of the injury and any recommended physical therapy. "The player should state in the application whether s/he intends to remain on the roster after recovering from the injury and completing any rehabilitation period." The minimum relief granted will be 15% of the annual fee; the maximum relief granted for extreme circumstances will be 30% of the annual fee. The Board of Directors will establish a committee to review any application for fee reduction and determine whether to grant a reduction and, if so, in what amount.

## **Scholarships:**

Bethesda Soccer Club has a limited amount of funds each year available for our members. The scholarship is awarded separately for each fall and spring season. You must apply each season for a scholarship. The application is reviewed by a committee established by the Board of Directors, whose decisions are final. Please go to our website [www.bethedasoccer.org](http://www.bethedasoccer.org) to download the application. Please note that applications for the Fall Season are due by July 23 and the Spring Season by March 1 (These dates subject to change). There are no extensions of the deadline. Applications received after the deadlines may not be reviewed or considered for scholarship assistance.

**You are required to pay your deposit even though you may be applying for a scholarship.**

## **Payment Schedule:**

An initial deposit of **\$250 is due by July 15<sup>th</sup>** to secure the player's roster spot. The remaining balance MAY be paid in 6 payments according to the following payment plans:

<b>Deposit</b>	<b>July 15</b>	<b>\$250.00</b>
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**Remaining payments** are spread equally. The amount of each payment is calculated as follows:

**Annual Player fee less deposit divided by 6 payments.** Each payment is due on the following dates:

<b>#1</b>	<b>September 15</b>
<b>#2</b>	<b>October 15</b>
<b>#3</b>	<b>November 15</b>
<b>#4</b>	<b>December 15</b>
<b>#5</b>	<b>January 15</b>
<b>#6</b>	<b>February 15</b>

Payments may be made by credit card or by personal check. Personal checks should be made out to the Bethesda Soccer Club and the player's full name and team noted in the memo. A \$25.00 processing fee will be assessed for all returned checks.

It is the player's/family's responsibility to remain current with the payments and maintain the membership in good standing.

In the event that payments are not made within 30 days of the payment due date, the club will take the following actions:

31 days late: Notify Coach and Manager of balance due and that member is not in good standing. Player will receive a warning that if payment is not made within 30 days, the Director of Coaching will be notified and appropriate actions will be recommended to the Board of Directors (suspension from games, suspension from practices and games, suspension from club, etc.)

61 days late: Director of Coaching will discuss past due balances with Board of Directors and appropriate sanctions of player and family will take place until such time as player and family become a member in good standing.

### **Refund Policy:**

Accepting a position on a Bethesda Soccer Club team is a commitment to the club and to the other members of the team **to play for the full soccer year**. In accordance with MSYSA regulations there may be circumstances that result in a player asking to be released from a team (see Mid-Season roster releases). This refund policy applies to players who voluntarily request a release from a team prior to the completion of the year (August 1 to July 31).

The Bethesda Soccer Club depends on the receipt of payments to pay for expenses during the seasonal year. As such, refunds are strongly disfavored and will be granted only in the rarest of circumstances.

Refunds for voluntary releases are provided on a case by case basis. To evaluate an application for refund, the following items will be taken into consideration.

1. Player being in good standing.
2. Evaluation of player by coach.
3. Comments from Director Coaching with regards to other options within the club.

Upon receipt of these items, the application will be reviewed and recommendation made with regards to a reasonable amount.

## **Parents Check List:**

Once you are notified your player has been accepted on one of our BSC teams for the 2011/2012 year, you need to do the following:

1. Give team manager all personal information; Player's name, Date Of Birth, Address, Phone Numbers, Parents Name(s), Email Addresses
2. Order and Pay for Uniform-suggest that you go to PJ's Sports to try on uniform before ordering. PJ's Sports is located at 10422 Auto Park Drive Bethesda, MD 20817
3. Manager will contact you regarding signing player card and registration form for league play. You will also need two 1x1 color head shot pictures of your player.
4. Register on BSC website. [Player Registration Information](#)
5. Pay \$250 de posit by personal check, credit card online from emailed invoice or completed credit card payment form.
